*I Understand the following: (You must sign at the bottom for your reservation to be accepted)*

*U.S. Spiritleaders must operate camps at a minimum of 500 students to maintain it's staff/student ratio and continue to teach elite choreography. Soka University has put a limit of 360 available beds for all camps. The facilities are above normal college facilities. In particular I understand that the Soka Dorms are of different sizes consisting of different floor plans. Typically the rooms can accommodate two people comfortably if the second person is on an air mattress. In a few instances, some room configurations are the size of two rooms and four people (2 beds / 2 air mattresses) will be housed together. I also understand that the Soka Camps are unique in that the facilities including the fields, cafeteria, and gym provide U.S. Spiritleaders with a basically private camp experience unlike other colleges.*

*The first 200 camp reservations will be provided the following:*

*All campers will be provided with beds except for the following conditions...1. If an advisor/adult requests a private/single room they must have one student share a room with an air mattress for every advisor/adult who is requesting a private room. 2. If an advisor/coach requests that all their students must stay on the same floor or dorm, I understand some students may have to share a room with an air mattress. (U.S. Spiritleaders will always try to place entire squads together but due to the size of the team or dorm availability this may not be possible)*

*Camp Reservations 201 through 400 understands the following: For every person who receives a bed, a second must sleep on an air mattress. If an advisor requests a private/single room an additional student must stay on an air mattress. The statements in the first two paragraphs also apply. I also understand that I must inform all team members and parents of the conditions of which my team has placed their reservation. Every person who sleeps on an air mattress will receive a price reduction of \$20.*

*Camp Reservations 401 through 700 understand the following: The Crowne Plaza Hotel of Irvine will be the host hotel for campers and advisors who wish to attend one of the three Soka Camps as residents and not commuters. All camp participants staying at the host hotel will be shuttled via bus.*

*Reservations do not guarantee rooms if the coach/advisor does not follow through with the deadlines. I understand if I am one of the first 200 camp reservations and I do not meet the deadlines I will be placed in the 201-400 category or even behind groups who are on hold.*
